Lansing Police Department January 2020 Activity Report

911 Center

- During the month of January, the Lansing 911 center handled 8,577, generating 4,407 police incident numbers.

Training

- Lt. Schoon and Sgt. Lazowski attended a Tactical Leadership course.
- Officers Catron and Miklusak attended an enhanced Traffic Enforcement Class.
- Sergeant Lazowski attended an Asset Forfeiture Manager class.
- Officers Bogan & Murrin III attended Footwear Impression and Latent Fingerprint class.
- Officers Miklusak and Prendergast attended a crime scene class in Latent Print Technology.

Activity

- 458 municipal citations were issued. (78 for Failure to Display Village Stickers).
- 345 State traffic offenses were issued. (Speeding, disobeyed stop signs, etc.)
- 105 Arrests were made during the month.
- 613 Traffic Stops / 118 Community Policing contacts/ 1585 Premise Checks were conducted.
- \$1,155 in Oxcart permits collected (11 Permits) & \$24,500 in administrative fees were collected.
- 18 abandoned vehicles were located and notices served.
- Another prostitution sting was conducted with Cook Co. S.D. – 4 violations were cited.
- **2019 year end activity stats: 392 abandoned autos located, 7,262 traffic stops, 2040 community policing contacts & 10,000 premise checks conducted, 1085 arrests made, 5,195 Municipal series issued (2447 for failure to display Village sticker) & 2501 State traffic offenses cited.**
