## Lansing Police Department February 2020 Activity Report

### 911 Center

- During the month of February, the Lansing 911 center handled 8,068, generating 4,008 police incident numbers.

### Training

- Lt. Phillips, Sgt. Lazowski, D.C's Slough and Roberts & Chief Murrin attended a webinar regarding Internal Affair Investigations.
- Officers attended a Hemorrhage Control class with the Fire Department.
- Several officers were re-certified by Sig Sauer as Armorers for the department.
- Officer Talavera-Little and Kacich attended Field Training officer school.

### Activity

- 753 municipal citations were issued. (464 for Failure to Display Village Stickers).
- 251 State traffic offenses were issued. (Speeding, disobeyed stop signs, etc.)
- 80 Arrests were made during the month.
- 520 Traffic Stops / 115 Community Policing contacts/ 1342 Premise Checks were conducted.
- \$17,000 in administrative fees were collected / 5 Oxcart permits were issued totaling \$350.00.
- **\$5282.50 in fees were collected by Municipal Collections of America as a result of LPD's Immobilization towing.**
- 19 abandoned vehicles were located and notices served.

- The DANGER program and ALICE Training are being presented at District 158 schools.
- Probationary police officer testing was held on February 29<sup>th</sup> at the Eisenhower Center. Officers Kacich, Miklusak, Murrin III, Ryan, and Chief Murrin conducted the orientation presentation. A total of 15 applicants attended the orientation and written test. 11 applicants successfully passed the written test and are scheduled to move forward in the testing process.
