## **Lansing Police Department March 2020 Activity Report**

### **911 Center**

- During the month of March, the Lansing 911 center handled 8,393, generating 3,657 police incident numbers.

### **The majority of the following activities took place prior to March 16<sup>th</sup>.**

### **Training**

- Officer VanKalker attended an Interview and Interrogation class.
- Officers Casson, Catron, and Tatgenhorst attended the Truck Enforcement Conference.
- Officers attended Mobile Field Force, and Major Accident training classes.

### **Activity**

- The annual wide winter Village Ticket Blitz concluded March 15th with 781 Village Sticker Violations cited.
- 198 State traffic offenses were issued. (Speeding, disobeyed stop signs, etc.)
- 80 Arrests were made during the month.
- 344 Traffic Stops / 140 Community Policing contacts/ 1194 Premise Checks were conducted.
- \$15,000 in administrative fees were collected / 4 Oxcart permits were issued totaling \$175.00.
- 29 abandoned vehicles were located and notices served.
- The new TAC unit conducted 2 search warrants where illegal drugs, weapons, and money were seized. Several arrests were made in relation to these warrants as well as other offenses.

### **Events Attended by LPD Staff**

- Coolidge Reading program, Citizen's Academy concluded, Beat 3 Neighborhood Watch meeting.

### **Miscellaneous**

- The Heating and Air Conditioning project was completed.
- The License plate reader cameras have been installed at Ridge and Wentworth Ave. Aside from some programming issues, these should be functional soon.
