Lansing Police Department April 2020 Activity Report

911 Center

- During the month of April, the Lansing 911 center handled 6,867 calls. 2,942 of these were police calls, and 417 were fire department calls.

Training

- Due to COVID-19 all training was cancelled during the month.

Activity

- 19 Municipal citations were issued in the month.
- 30 State traffic offenses were issued. (Speeding, disobeyed stop signs, etc.)
- 26 Arrests were made during the month.
- 26 Traffic Stops / 56 Community Policing contacts/ 1128 Premise Checks were conducted.
- \$3,000 in administrative fees were collected.
- 21 abandoned vehicles were located and notices served.
- The new TAC unit conducted 2 search warrants where illegal drugs, weapons, and money were seized. Several arrests were made in relation to these warrants as well as other offenses.

Events Attended by LPD Staff

- Birthday parades were completed during the month.

Miscellaneous

- Officers A'Hearn and Ryan were cleared for solo patrol after completing the field training program.
- LPD was awarded a grant through the Illinois Dept. of Public Health to be used for the purchases of a Zoll AED and accessories.
- All LPD vehicles received a deep cleaning during the month, and PPE gear is well stocked.
