

**MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF FIRE AND POLICE COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING HELD MAY 5, 2021**

CALL TO ORDER:

On Wednesday, May 5, 2021, a regular meeting of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners was called to order at 5:00 p.m. at the Lansing Municipal Center.

ROLL CALL:

Gabriel Barajas was appointed to the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners at the April 13, 2021 Village Board Meeting to replace Commissioner John Pizzato who resigned effective April 1, 2021.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Commissioner Cuthbert made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Vitiritti to approve the April 8, 2021 minutes. The motion carried with a unanimous voice vote.

APPROVAL OF BILLS:

Commissioner Vitiritti presented the following bills in the amount of \$1,481 -

Commissioner Cuthbert made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Vitiritti to approve the bills as presented. The motion carried with a unanimous voice vote.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Commissioners reviewed the submitted requests for preference points from firefighter candidates to be added to scores on the initial eligibility list. Commissioner Barajas made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Cuthbert to approve the Probationary Firefighter/Paramedic Final Eligibility List with the additional preference points submitted. The motion carried with a unanimous voice vote.

The police officer applications will be available to download from the village website on Monday, May 10, 2021. The completed applications will be due by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 2, 2021. The applications will be reviewed for completeness on that day at the regular meeting. The written exam will be on Saturday, June 12, 2021 with the interviews on June 15, 16, and possibly June 18. Interview schedule depends on number of applicants who pass the written exam.
