## Lansing Police Department June 2020 Activity Report

### 911 Center

- During the month of June, the Lansing 911 center handled 10,252 calls. Of these there were 3892 police calls.

### Training

- The LPD Emergency response team conducted training during the month.

### Activity

- 359 Traffic Stops / 168 Community Policing contacts/ 1058 premise checks were conducted.
- 39 Arrests were made during the month.
- 50 Municipal citations were issued in the month.
- 219 State traffic offenses were issued. (Speeding, disobeyed stop signs, etc.)
- \$13,500 in administrative fees were collected / 13 Oxcart Permits were issued in June totaling \$575.00 in fees collected.
- 7 abandoned vehicles were located and notices served.
- The Tactical Unit executed a search warrant resulting in the seizure of over 200 grams of Heroin, \$1600 in cash, and a vehicle.

### Miscellaneous

- Craig Kowalski was hired to replace Donna Bergstrom as the Assistant Supervisor of 911. Craig comes to LPD with over 13 years of dispatch and supervisory experience in both the Aurora and Oak Lawn Police Departments.
- Through a proposal submitted by LT. Bailey, LPD received an IDOT step grant for over \$104,000 for the upcoming year for enforcement of traffic related offenses.
- LT. Bailey also renewed our NARCAN grant through ILEAS.
- New LED lighting was obtained by Sgt. Mike Hynek courtesy of the COMED Efficiency program for the department at no cost. This new lighting was installed by Sgt. Hynek as well.
- SOC Weis obtained several ILEAS 800mhz in car radios from ILEAS at no cost to LPD which will be installed in some of our unmarked vehicles.
