Lansing Police Department August 2020 Activity Report

911 Center

- During the month of August, the Lansing 911 center handled 9638 calls. Of these, there were 4025 police calls.

Training

- Officers Meyer and Stanton attended a Crime Scene processing training class.
- Officer Talavera-Little attended SSERT training.
- Sgt. Weeden and D.C. Roberts attended a Virtual training conference regarding Body Worn Camera Policy and Implementation.
- Officer Casson and Talavera-Little attended Taser Instructor training.

Activity

- 738 Traffic Stops / 135 Community Policing contacts/ 1115 premise checks were conducted.
- 97 Arrests were made during the month.
- 187 Municipal citations were issued in the month.(78 for having no Village Stickers)
- 443 State traffic offenses were issued. (Speeding, disobeyed stop signs, etc.)
- \$26,500 in administrative fees were collected/ 2 Oxcart permits were issued (\$75.00 in fees collected)
- 12 abandoned vehicles were located and notices served.
- The patrol division concentrated efforts on speed enforcement offenses, vehicles avoiding traffic control devices, and sex offender compliance checks.
