Lansing Police Department October 2019 Activity Report

911 Center

- During the month of October, the 911 center handled 8602 calls and 4,025 police incident numbers were created.

Training

- Ofc. Fitzgerald attended an Illinois vehicle code refresher course.
- New officers Victor Aviles and James Burke began their Field Training Program.
- Officer Robert Garcia was promoted to Sergeant, and Sergeant Jason Klausner was promoted to Lieutenant.
- Officers Haan and Talavera-Little were selected to become new members of the LPD Emergency Response Team. Officer Olin, Robles, and Kacich were selected as new Field Training officers.

Activity

- 375 municipal citations were issued. (125 for Failure to Display Village Stickers).
- 360 State traffic offenses were issued. (Speeding, disobeyed stop signs, etc.)
- 102 Arrests were made during the month.
- 619 Traffic Stops / 175 Community Policing contacts/ 893 Premise Checks were conducted.
- \$585.00 in Oxcart permits collected (7 Permits) & \$19,500 in administrative fees were collected.

Concentrated efforts were provided by the patrol division on abandoned vehicles during the month.

101 abandoned vehicles were cited.
