Who Can Participate?

Any youth 15-18 years old (may stay in program until age 21), currently enrolled in school (H.S. or College) serving the Village of Lansing, and having good moral character and clear criminal background.

What is the Cadet Program? A program designed to allow young people interested in Law Enforcement an opportunity to learn first-hand through classroom studies and field participation.

When does this happen?

A Basic Training Academy begins in late September of each year and operates every Tuesday and Thursday evening from 7:00 PM - 10:00 PM. There will be occasional Saturdays for firearms training.

Where do I train at? The Lansing Police Department classroom and training facilities.

How is training conducted?

The Basic Training Academy consists of 200 hours of comprehensive classroom and practical studies covering Criminal Law, Illinois Vehicle Code, Traffic Stops, Search & Seizure, First Aid, C.P.R., and various other topics.

- The instructors are Law Enforcement professionals from multiple agencies, including Lansing Police Officers, State, and Federal Agents.
- Tour of Cook County Court facilities.
- Radio room training following academy completion.
- Team stress/confidence course at Iron's Oaks.
- Patrol Ride-Along program.
- Attendance at State and National conferences and competitions.

- Crime Prevention.
