## Lansing Police Department October 2020 Activity Report

### 911 Center

- The Lansing 911 center handled 8537 calls, of these there were 3688 police calls.

### Training

- Sergeants Garcia and Weeden attended an Alice Threat Training class.
- Officer Talavera-Little attended SSERT training.
- Sergeant Garcia attended Ballistic Shield Training.
- Officer Mike Rafferty is attending the 80 hour Basic Police Academy Full Time Transition course.

### Activity

- 654 Traffic Stops / 111 Community Policing contacts/ 1119 premise checks were conducted.
- 105 Arrests were made.
- 418 Municipal citations were issued in the month. (326 for having no Village Stickers)
- 430 State traffic offenses were issued. (Speeding, disobeyed stop signs, etc.)
- \$20,000 in administrative fees were collected. Four Oxcart fees were collected (\$490.00).
- 62 abandoned vehicles were located and notices served.
- **The patrol division concentrated enforcement efforts on village sticker offenses between September 15<sup>th</sup> and October 15<sup>th</sup>. A total of 915 citations were issued during this time. Between October 15<sup>th</sup> and November 15<sup>th</sup>, officers will be concentrating their efforts on abandoned vehicles throughout the Village.**
- The tactical unit conducted 2 search warrants during the month, making several arrests and seizing illegal contraband.

### Miscellaneous

- Officers attended the Fox Pointe Halloween events, First Christian Church Trunk or Treat, Water's Edge Ribbon Cutting ceremony, and Thrivent Financial Ribbon cutting ceremony.
- Officers attended the food giveaway event at Methodist Church and the Village's shredding event.
- The DEA Takeback day netted 60 lbs. of turned in medications.
- LPD was awarded the Dept. Of Justice BulletProof Vest Grant in the amount of \$3985 which covers 50% of the cost of vests for officers.
- LPD participated in the Illinois Dept. of Transportation Halloween Grant Campaign aimed at seatbelt and DUI violations.
